### **Presentation Opportunities**

As a participant, you will be part of a new and unique opportunity underway in New Mexico to present your contributions to classroom best practices or research outcomes that are fostering increased learning in STEM classrooms for all students. Selected participants will have the opportunity to present at this statewide STEM conference via two different venues: poster presentation or our micro-brew sharing sessions.

Poster and microbrew sessions will focus on sharing classroom best practices and/or research challenges and data in any area of STEM education.

**Poster Session** will be the afternoon of October 30th. Poster boards will accommodate posters that are up to 48" high and 40" wide.

**Microbrew Sessions** are short, interactive presentations scheduled for the afternoon of October 30th. Each microbrew presenter will have a total of 15 minutes to share an activity, intervention or research challenge, and get feedback. Demonstrations that engage colleagues are highly encouraged.
